

2022 LISD Championship
Bass Tournament, Sat. April 2
Rules and Entry Information

Tournament Waters: Anglers will compete exclusively on the waters of Lake Tawakoni in East Texas.

Tournament Rules: The general rules of the KBS and THSBA shall apply with the following exceptions noted on this flyer.

All competitors must each have their own Android or iOS smartphone or I-pad, fully charged and on their person. We will utilize “Fish Donkey” which is a web-based program, to record real-time results.

Entry Requirements

All anglers must:

1. Be a current member in good standing of a Lewisville ISD THSBA team.
2. Download and install the “Fish Donkey” app on the phone that they will use during the competition.
3. At least one person from each competing boat must attend the pre-tournament meeting which will take place on Friday, April 1st @ 3:45 PM in the FM9 cafeteria. It is strongly recommended that every angler and boat captain attend the meeting if at

all possible. At the meeting, each boat will be issued 1 calibrated scale that is required to be used for the tournament.

Format: This event will use the “MLF” tournament format minus the fish-landing penalties.

Eligible Bass Species: All largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass that weigh .5 Kg or more shall be scored.

Possession Limit: ZERO. All bass shall be immediately weighed, photographed, and released. **Exception:** Any bass caught that is believed to be a Junior Record may be retained. In such an event, every attempt should be made to keep the fish healthy to be released alive.

Weigh-in:

Each bass shall be weighed in Kilograms. If it weighs .5 Kg or more, it should be photographed and released immediately thereafter. An angler may weigh his own bass, however, the other parties on the boat must be able to verify the weight of each bass for all competitors on the boat. (SHOW EVERYONE THE WEIGHT!) The weight and photo of each bass weighing .5 Kg or more shall be posted immediately on “Fish Donkey”.

Tournament Divisions Defined: There shall be three divisions contested at this event; a student angler division, a student

“Big Bass” division, and a Captain division. **All anglers in will compete as individuals.** No team scores will be kept.

Prizes and Awards: The top 3 anglers in the student division will each receive a plaque and a prize. The top captain and the student angler weighing in the “Big Bass” of the tournament will also receive a plaque.

Launch: All boats may launch at the ramp of their choice beginning at 6:30 AM. **This is a trailering event.**

Competition Period: First Cast is at 7:00 AM. Competition ends at 3:00 PM. “Fish Donkey” will not record any catch prior to 7:00 AM or entered after 3:00 PM

Awards Presentation: Awards will be presented on Monday, April 4th at 3:45 PM in the FM9 Cafeteria. At least one member from each boat must attend AND return the scale issued to their respective boat in order for the anglers on that boat to be awarded FMHS AOY points for the tournament.

In the event of a dangerous weather forecast as determined by the tournament director, the event will be cancelled and rescheduled if possible. Contestants will be notified by Team Reach before Friday, midnight.
